Please allow <u>at least 2 weeks</u> for your recommendation to be completed. For example, if recommendations for your school are due on 7/15, all recommendation materials should be submitted no later than 7/1.

A request for recommendation not submitted within the required timeline cannot guarantee you a recommendation, but we will try our best. Getting your recommendation materials to us in a timely manner gives us time to find an Alpha Chi Omega alumna from your school to do the recommendation.

- [2] Character Moral integrity, dignity, and loyalty
- [3] Financial Responsibility Prompt payment of dues and fees and other financial obligations
- [4] Leadership Ability Participation in campus and community activities
- [5] Personal Development social awareness, poise, personal presentation and cultural appreciation

## 1. Academic Interest

- How have you strived for and shown academic interest?
- Where do your academic interests lie?
- What major are you considering and why?

## 2. Character

- How do you demonstrate responsibility for your actions?
- How do you interact with others?
- How would you describe yourself in 3 words?

## 3. Leadership ability

- If you have had a leadership position(s) in school or in your community activities, what has this position(s) taught you about being a leader?
- If you haven't had any leadership positions, what has being part of a team taught you about leadership and being a team player?
- Are you interested in running for any leadership positions within the sorority? What would you bring to the table?

- 4. Financial responsibility
  - Give an example(s) of how you show or have had to show financial responsibility and what it taught you.
  - How do you honor your financial commitments, bills, etc.?
  - How do you plan to pay for dues?
- 5. Personal development
  - How do you express social awareness and cultural appreciation?
  - Do you have any philanthropic causes?
  - What are your interests, hobbies, and talents outside of school?
  - What are your personal goals?
  - What are you passionate about?

5. Personal Optional recommendation
